Directions & Parking

To UConn

Take I-84 east/west to exit 68 (Route 195), follow Route 195 south approximately 7 miles (crossing routes 32 and 44). The UConn campus is 1 mile past the intersection of Route 44.

To Jorgensen & CRT - Harriet S. Jorgensen Theatre

Follow directions to UConn above. At traffic light (large brick church on right), turn right from Route 195 onto North Eagleville Road. Turn left at second traffic light onto North Hillside Road, and left into Parking Garage. Jorgensen is located diagonally across the street. CRT is located on the opposite side of the Jorgensen building, on the lower level.

To CRT Studio & Nafe Katter Theatres

Continue south on Route 195 (past lake on right) and turn right at light onto Mansfield Road. Take first left onto Coventry Road. The Nafe Katter Theatre is straight ahead and parking is on the right. CRT Studio Theatre is in the Drama/Music building, corner of Route 195 and Bolton Road.

Parking

The cost for parking in the North Parking Garage for Jorgensen and CRT performances (at the HSJ Theatre) is included in the ticket price.

Ample parking is available across from Jorgensen in the garage, Lots 9 and X, as well as in the South Parking Garage next to Gampel Pavilion. Additional parking is available in Lots F and L on North Hillside Road. For a detailed map, go to www.park.uconn.edu. Please be aware that there will be parking and traffic issues when UConn Athletics schedules events at the same time as Jorgensen and CRT events. Consult www.uconnhuskies.com or your local newspaper for a schedule of athletic events and allow extra time for travel and parking.
